## Sermon Notes "Power Over Sickness" Matthew 8:1-17

Matthew has an agenda in writing his gospel: it's not just to narrate a biography, it's to convince you that Jesus is the Messiah and that he is worthy to be praised and worshiped as God.

He has shown us Jesus' lineage, the prophecies concerning him, his power over Satan and temptation, and the authority of his teaching.

Today's passage shows that Jesus has power over sickness and that Jesus had both the ability and the compassion needed to heal those who were suffering.

We can trust Jesus as God because he is the Messiah with power over all things.

## On This Day

Joseph Lister belongs on a short list of the world's greatest doctors. His research taught him that killing germs would save lives and allow surgeons to operate inside bodies. His greatest contribution was to show that infections were caused by germs. Lister hunted for something that would kill germs while not injuring body tissues. He discovered that carbolic acid (phenol) kills germs. Its use greatly decreased death rates after surgery. He told a graduating class: "It is our proud office to tend the fleshly tabernacle of the immortal spirit, and our path, if rightly followed, will be guided by unfettered truth and love unfeigned. In pursuit of this noble and holy calling I wish you all God-speed." When he died on February 10, 1912, he was recognized around the world as one of the great benefactors of mankind.
