## Sermon Notes

### **Matthew 9:1-8 :“Power Over Sin”**

While this passage seems to be merely another example of Jesus' power to heal, it's actually about Jesus' power to forgive sins.

Matthew once again shows that Jesus is God by showing that he can heal: this proves that Jesus has the power to forgive sins since only God can truly forgive our sins.

Our greatest need in life is not in this physical world, it's our spiritual need for forgiveness. Matthew shows us in this passage that Jesus has the power to save us from our sins.

And behold, some people brought to him a paralytic, lying on a bed. And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." -Matthew 9:2
