Sermon Notes

"Temptation" **Genesis 3:1-7**

We all face temptation and probably wonder: if God made a perfect world, why is there temptation and sin?

Today's passage explains how sin entered the world.

Eight characteristics of temptation:

1. Temptation questions God's Word
2. Temptation downplays God's goodness.
3. Temptation exaggerates God's strictness.
4. Temptation diminishes God's judgement.
5. Temptation denies God's word.
6. Temptation questions God's motives.
7. Temptation promises us benefits from disobedience.
8. Temptation appeals to the senses.

Jesus can be our savior because He is the New Adam who overcame temptation to become a perfect sacrifice.

"Take and eat": either the fruit of temptation or the Body of Christ. We celebrate Communion as a reminder of Christ's power over sin for us.

So when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was a delight to the eyes, and that the tree was to be desired to make one wise, she took of its fruit and ate, and she also gave some to her husband who was with her, and he ate.
